

STUDENT/TEACHER/PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Teachers are held responsible for educating their students on the procedures of the event. Please take the time to communicate these rules and regulations with your student and the students' parents or guardians.

- Every participant will receive a graded certificate and judge's commentary. Winners will receive a winner's certificate, medal and monetary prize.
- Grades are as follows: Outstanding Performer, Award of Excellence, and Honorable Mention. Certificates and Comment Sheets will be given out to the students or their teachers following the announcement of the Winners
- Winners are required to perform in the Winners Recital. Medals and Prize Awards are awarded at the Winners Recital.
- Winners will be posted on our Website: www.atlmta.org.

- Every participant should present a proof of age or grade in school: a student I.D., at the registration desk.
- Application Fees are nonrefundable.
- The judges' decisions are final.
- Students must be dressed in formal or semiformal attire. Students wearing inappropriate attire, such as: jeans, sneakers, tee-shirts, flip-flops will be disqualified.

- Students will be known to judge by number only. Teachers, parents are not allowed to talk to the judge.
- Students are required to check at the Registration Desk at least 20 minutes before assigned performance time.
- Students must provide judge with an original score of music for each piece with all measures numbers. Photocopies are PROHIBITED.

- Memorization of Two contrasting pieces is required. Both pieces may be from the Romantic Period, or One piece may be from the Romantic Period, and One piece may be from the Impressionistic Period.
- Performance time limit will be strictly monitored. The judge reserves the right to stop a student on either or both pieces for the sake of time at his/her discretion.
- Students are allowed to warm up on practice pianos provided. Monitors will direct the students to the practice area and monitor the practice times.
- Please maintain a quiet environment while waiting for your students and children to finish their audition.
